

Primary 4a Snow Pack

Activities

- *Look out of your window. Describe what you see using adjectives and WOW words.
- *Imagine you are a weather presenter on the television. Write a short weather report for Banff and the local area. You might also like to include a travel report to warn people of the dangers of travelling or say how things have been affected.
- *Use your reading book (or another book of your choice) and
 - write down all the different words that have been used for 'said'.
 - write down all the different types of punctuation that have been used.
 - find and write down 8 nouns
 - find and write down 8 verbs
 - find as many adjectives or adverbs as you can
- *Make a list of 20 words from a book and write them in alphabetical order
- *Get someone to help you to practise the number bonds so that you know them **really** well! It will make all of your maths easier. These are good ones to know $8+3$, $8+4$, $8+5$, $8+7$, $6+5$, $6+7$, $6+8$, $6+3$, $5+4$, $4+3$, the others will be easier as they might be doubles, close to doubles are ones that make 10. (Remember to try them with the numbers swapped round)
- *Learn the 2, 3, 4 and 5 times table so that you know the answers like lightning!!
- *Make a snowman and take a photo of it (if you can!)
- *Try writing your spelling words in the snow
